ASSET papers are designed by subject experts who specialize in designing questions that test the understanding of concepts taught in the three core subjects. This skill-based, diagnostic assessment is based on age-appropriate real-life applications which would eventually help students to be successful in competitive examinations later in life.

After the ASSET test, your child will receive a personalised comprehensive view of his/her performance, along with detailed insights on his/her strengths and areas that need improvement. Your child will also get benchmarked with his/her/ peers across the country and internationally, to help them understand where they stand, along with targeted practice questions.

Due to its importance as a benchmarking assessment, we feel that students will benefit if we, as an institution, provide our students the support needed, by giving due importance to the ASSET Examination.

Therefore, the ASSET will be considered as Periodic Test 3 in English, Math, and Science for Grades 3 to 9 in the month of January 2023. Details of the dates will be shared later this week along with the schedule.
